58. (VI) Matthew 10:28 Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in hell.
59. (V) Matthew 10:37 Anyone who loves his father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; anyone who loves his son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.
60. (III) Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding.

64. (V) Psalm 14:1 The fool says in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, their deeds are vile;
65. (IV) Psalm 33:8 Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all the people of the world revere him.
66. (III) Genesis 17:1 I am God Almighty; walk before me and be blameless.
67. (III) Genesis 39:9 How then could I do such a wicked thing and sin against God?
68. (III) Proverbs 8:13 To fear the Lord is to hate evil.
69. *(II) Matthew 22:37 Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.
71. (II) Psalm 118:8 It is better to take refuge in the Lord than to trust in man.
74. (IV) Jeremiah 23:6 This is the name by which he will be saved: The Lord Our Righteousness.
77. (IV) Exodus 20:7 The Lord will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.
79. (VII) James 3:9-10 With the tongue we praise our Lord and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in God's likeness. Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing. My brothers, this should not be.

80. (VI) 2 Corinthians 1:23 I call God as my witness.
81. (III) Romans 13:1 Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities.
82. (V) Deuteronomy 6:13 Fear the Lord your God, serve him only and take your oaths in his name.
84. (VI) Matthew 5:33-37 Again, you have heard that it was said to the people long ago, 'Do not break your oath, but keep the oaths you have made to the Lord.' But I tell you, Do not swear at all: either by heaven, for it is God's throne; or by the earth, for it is his footstool; or by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the Great King. 93. (I) Psalm 50:15 Call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me.
94. (II) Matthew 7:7 Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.
95. (III) Psalm 103:1 Praise the Lord, O my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name.
96. (I) Psalm 118:1 Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever.
97. (II) Matthew 12:8 For the Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath.
98. (VII) Colossians 2:16-17 Therefore do not let anyone judge you by what you eat or drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day. These are a shadow of the things that were to come; the reality, however, is found in Christ.
101. (*)(VI) Hebrews 10:25 Let us not give up meeting, together, as some are in the habit of doing.

102. (VI) Acts 2:42 They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.
103. ((V) John 8:47 He who belongs to God hears what God says. The reason you do not hear is that you do not belong to God.
104. (VI) Luke 10:16 He who listens to you listens to me; he who rejects you rejects me; but he who rejects me rejects him who sent me.
105. (VII) 1 Thessalonians 2:13 When you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men, but as it actually is, the word of God.
107. (VI) Ecclesiastes 5:1 Guard your steps when you go to the house of God. Go near to listen rather than to offer the sacrifice of fools, who do not know that they do wrong.
108. (VI) Psalm 26:8 I love the house where you live, O Lord, the place where your glory dwells.
110. (II) Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly
113. (VI) Hebrews 13:17 Obey your leaders and submit to their authority. They keep watch over you as men who must give an account. Obey them so that their work will be a joy, not a burden, for that would be of no advantage to you.
114. (VI) Galatians 6:6-7 Anyone who receives instruction in the word must share all good things with his instructor. Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows.
115. (IV) Mark 16:15 Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation.
116. (VII) Galatians 6:10 Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.
117. (I) Matthew 5:44 Love your enemies.
118. (V) Matthew 7:12 So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you, for this sums up the Law and the Prophets.
119. (VI) Proverbs 30:17 "The eye that mocks a father, that scorns obedience to a mother, will be pecked out by the ravens of the valley, will be eaten by the vultures.
121. (V) Ephesians 6:2-3 Honor your father and mother—which is the first commandment with a promise—that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth.

122. (IV) Leviticus 19:31 Rise in the presence of the aged, show respect for the elderly and revere your God.
124. (I) Colossians 3:20 Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord.
126. (VI) 1 Peter 2:18 Slaves, submit yourselves to your masters with all respect, not only to those who are good and considerate, but also to those who are harsh.
127. (II) Acts 5:29 We must obey God rather than men:
128. (IV) Genesis 9:6 "Whoever sheds the blood of man, by man shall his blood be shed; for in the image of God has God made man.
129. (II) Matthew 26:52 For all who draw the sword will die by the sword.
130. (VI) Romans 13:4 He does not bear the sword for nothing. He is God's servant, an agent of wrath to bring punishment on the wrongdoer.
131. (VI) Romans 12:19 Do not take revenge, my friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord.
132. (VI) Matthew 5:22 But I tell you that anyone who is angry with his brother will be subject to judgment.
133. (III) 1 John 3:15 Anyone who hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life in him.
134. (IV) Matthew 15:19 For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false testimony, slander.
135. (IV) Ephesians 4:26 "In your anger do not sin": Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry.
136. (V) Romans 12:20 If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head."
138. (VI) Matthew 5:25 "Settle matters quickly with your adversary who is taking you to court. Do it while you are still with him on the way, or he may hand you over to the judge, and the judge may hand you over to the officer, and you may be thrown into prison.
142. (IV) Matthew 19:6 So they are no longer two, but one. Therefore what God has joined together, let man not separate.

143. (VII) Matthew 19:9 I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for marital unfaithfulness, and marries another woman commits adultery.
146. (VI) Matthew 5:28 But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart.
148. (IV) Ephesians 5:12 For it is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret.
151. (VII) Ephesians 4:29 Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.
154. (VII) Proverbs 23:31-32 Do not gaze at wine when it is red, when it sparkles in the cup, when it goes down smoothly! In the end it bites like a snake and poisons like a viper. Your eyes will see strange sights and your mind imagine confusing things.
155. (II) 1 Corinthians 6:18 Flee from sexual immorality.
156. (III) 2 Timothy 2:22 Flee the evil desires of youth.
158. (II) Proverbs 1:10 My son, if sinners entice you, do not give in to them.
160. (V) Ephesians 4:28 He who has been stealing must steal no longer, but must work, doing something useful with his own hands, that he may have something to share with those in need.
163. (III) 2 Thessalonians 3:10 If a man will not work, he shall not eat.
164. (III) Psalm 37:24 The wicked borrow and do not repay.
165. (III) Proverbs 29:24 The accomplice of a thief is his own enemy.
169. (V) Matthew 5:42 Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you.
170. (VI) Proverbs 19:17 He who is kind to the poor lends to the Lord, and he will reward him for what he has done.
173. (III) Proverbs 19:5 A false witness will not go unpunished.
174. (I) Proverbs 19:5 He who pours out lies will not be free.
176. (VI) Proverbs 11:13 A gossip betrays a confidence, but a trustworthy man keeps a secret.
177. (II) James 4:11 Brothers, do not slander one another.
179. (V) Luke 6:37 Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned.

180. (IV) Matthew 18:15 If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you.
181. (III) Zechariah 8:17 Don not plot evil against your neighbor.
183. (II) 1 Peter 4:8 Love covers over a multitude of sins.
184. (IV) 1 Corinthians 13:7 It (Love) always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.
185. (VII) Isaiah 5:8 Woe to you who add house to house and join field to field till no space is left and you live alone in the land.
187. (VII) 1 Timothy 6:8-10 But if we have food and clothing, we will be content with that. People who want to get rich fall into temptation and a trap and into many foolish and harmful desires that plunge men into ruin and destruction. For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.
189. (I) Galatians 5:13 Serve one another in love.
190. (VI) Romans 7:7 For I would not have known what coveting really was if the law had not said, "Do not covet."
193. (IV) Matthew 5:48 Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.
194. (V) Psalm 37:4 Delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart.
196. (I) Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death.
197. (VII) Ezekiel 18:20 The soul who sins is the one who will die. The son will not share the guilt of the father, nor will the father share the guilt of the son. The righteousness of the righteous man will be credited to him, and the wickedness of the wicked will be charged against him.
199. (VI) Genesis 32:10 I am unworthy of all the kindness and faithfulness you have shown your servant.
200. (IV) 1 John 5:3 This is love for God: to obey his commands
202. (IV) James 2:10 For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles at just one point is guilty of breaking all of it
203. (V) Psalm 14:3 All have turned aside, they have together become corrupt; there is no one who does good, not even one.
204. (III) Ecclesiastes 7:20 There is not a righteous man on earth who does what is right and never sins.

205. (IV) Isaiah 64:6 All of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous acts are like filthy rags.
207. (IV) Psalm 143:2 Do not bring your servant into judgment, for no one living is righteous before you.
208. (V) 1 John 1:8 If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.
209. (VII) 1 Timothy 1:9 We also know that law is made not for the righteous but for lawbreakers and rebels, the ungodly and sinful, the unholy and irreligious; for those who kill their fathers or mothers, for murders.
211. (II) Romans 3:20 Through the law we become conscious of sin.
215. (II) 1 John 3:8 He who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning.
216. (II) Romans 5:12 Sin entered the world through one man.
217. (V) Psalm 51:5 Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me.
218. (V) John 3:6 Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit.
220. (III) Genesis 8:21 Every inclination of his heart is evil from childhood.
221. (III) Romans 7:18 I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature * Or my flesh
223. (III) Ephesians 2:1 As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins.
226. (VI) Romans 5:12 Death came to all men, because all sinned.
231. (IV) James 4:17 Anyone, then, who knows the good he ought to do and doesn't do it, sins.
232. (V) Romans 10:4 Christ is the end of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes.
233. (VI) Galatians 3:14 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."
234. (III) Romans 10:14 How can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard?
235. (IV) Romans 10:17 Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.

236. (VI) Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.
238. (IV) Psalm 37:5 Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him and he will do this.
240. (I) Habakkuk 2:4 The righteous will live by his faith.
241. (II) Luke 7:50 Your faith has saved you; go in peace.
242. (VI) John 20:17 I am returning to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.
245. (I) Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
247. (V) Colossians 1:16 For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible.
248. (VI) Hebrews 1:14 Are not all angels ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation?
249. (III) Matthew 25:31 When the Son of Man comes in His glory and all the angels with Him, He will sit on His throne in heavenly glory.
250. (III) Luke 2:13 Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying,
253. (VII) Psalm 103:20-21 Praise the Lord, you his angels, you mighty ones who do his bidding, who obey his word. Praise the Lord, all his heavenly hosts, you his servants who do his will.
155. (V) Psalm 91:11-12 For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.
259. (VII) John 8:44 He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies.
260. (V) Peter 5:8-9 So self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that your brothers throughout the world are undergoing the same kind of sufferings.
261. (V) Genesis 2:7 The Lord God formed the man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being.

264. (VI) Ephesians 4:24 And put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.
265. (VII) Genesis 5:3 Adam . . . he had a son in his own likeness, in his own image.
267. (IV) Psalm 139:14 I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.
268. (III) Psalm 36:6 O Lord, you preserve both man and beast.
269. (III) Hebrews 1:3 He sustains all things by his powerful work.
270. (IV) Psalm 145:15-16 The eyes of all look to you, and you give them their food at the proper time. You open your hand and satisfy the desires of every living thing.
271. (I) 1 Peter 5:7 Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.
272. (VI) Matthew 10:29-30 Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground apart from the will of your Father. And even the very hairs of your head are numbered.
273. (IV) Psalm 91:10 then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent.
277. (II) Psalm 103:13 As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear him;
281. (IV) Matthew 1:21 She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name of Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins.
282. (V) Acts 4:12 Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.
284. (IV) Acts 10:38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power.
287. (VI) John 3:36 Whoever rejects the son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him."
288. (VII) 2 Timothy 1:12 I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him for that day.
289. (III) I John 5:20 He is the true God and eternal life.
290. (III) John 20:28 Thomas said to him "My Lord and my God:"
293. (V) John 1:1-2 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning.

294. (III) Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.
295. (II) Matthew 28:20 And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.
297. (II) Matthew 28:20 All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.
298. (IV) John 1:3 Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.
300. (III) Matthew 9:6 But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins.
303. (III) Hebrews 1:6 Let all God's angels worship him.
304. (V) I Timothy 2:5 For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,
305. (VI) Luke 24:39-40 Look at my hands and my feet. It is I myself! Touch me and see; a ghost does not have flesh and bones, as you see I have. When he had said this, he showed them his hands and feet.
306. (IV) Matthew 26:38 My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death.
307. (VII) John 1:14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.
310. (VI) Isaiah 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
314. (I) 1 John 1:7 The blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.
315. *(VII) Galatians 4:4-5 But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons.
319. (VII) Mark 10:45 For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.
320. (II) 2 Timothy 1:10 Christ Jesus has destroyed death.
322. (VI) 1 Corinthians 15:57 But thanks be to God: He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
324. (IV) Matthew 17:5 This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!
328. (IV) I Corinthians 15:3 Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures,

330. (VII) I John 2:1-2 But if anybody does sin, we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense—Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world.
333. (VII) 2 Timothy 4:18 The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to his heavenly kingdom. To him be glory for ever and ever. Amen.
335. (VI) Luke 1:35 The angel answered, “The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God.
336. (VI) Matthew 1:20 Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.
337. (IV) Isaiah 7:14 The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel.
338. (I) Isaiah 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given.
339. (IV) Luke 2:7 and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.
341. (VI) Matthew 8:20 Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has no place to lay his head.
347. (IV) John 19:30 with that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.
348. (IV) Galatians 3:13 For it is written: “Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree.”
349. (VI) Acts 13:27 But the one whom God raised from the dead did not see decay.
351. (V) 2 Corinthians 5:21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
352. (II) John 1:29 Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world.
355. (VII) John 8:34,36 Jesus replied, “I tell you the truth, everyone who sins is a slave to sin. So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.
359. (V) Genesis 3:15 And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring* and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.” *Or seed
360. (VI) I John 3:8 The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil’s work.

361. (II) James 4:7 Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

TABLE OF DUTIES

Or certain passages of scripture for various holy orders and estates whereby these are severally to be admonished as to their office and duty.

TO BISHOPS, PASTORS, AND PREACHERS.

Now, a bishop must be above reproach, the husband of one wife, temperate, sensible, dignified, hospitable, and apt teacher, no drunkard, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, and no lover of money. He must manage his own household well, keeping his children submissive and respectful in every way; he must not be a recent convert; he must hold firm to the sure word as taught, so that he may be able to give instruction in sound doctrine and also to confute those who contradict it. 1 Timothy. 3:2,2, 4, 6; Titus 1:9.

WHAT THE HEARERS OWE TO THEIR PASTORS.

Eat and drink what they provide, for the laborer deserves his wages. Luke 10:7

In the same way, the Lord commanded that those how proclaim the gospel should get their living by the gospel. 1 Cor. 9:14.

Let him who is taught the word share all good things with him who teaches. Do not be deceived; God is not mocked, for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. Gal. 6:6, 7.

Let the elders who rule well be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who labor in preaching and teaching; for the scripture says, "You shall not muzzle an ox when it is treading out the grain," and "The laborer deserves his wages." 1 Tim. 5:17, 18.

But we beseech you, brethren, to respect those who labor among you and are over you in the Lord and admonish you, and to esteem them very highly in love because of their work. Be at peace among yourselves. 1 Thess. 5:12, 13

Obey your leaders and submit to them; for they are keeping watch over your souls, as men who will have to give account. Let them do this joyfully, and not sadly, for that would be of no advantage to you. Heb. 13:17

OF CIVIL GOVERNMENT.

Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God. Therefore he who resists the authorities resists what God has appointed, and those who resist will incur judgment. For rulers are not a terror to good conduct, but to bad. Would you have

no fear of him who is in authority? Then do what is good, and you will receive his approval, for he is God's servant for your good. But if you do wrong, be afraid, for he does not bear the sword in vain; he is the servant of God to execute wrath on the wrongdoer. Rom 13:1-4.

OF SUBJECTS.

Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar's and to God the things that are God's Matt. 22:21.

Therefore one must be subject, not only to avoid God's wrath but also for the sake of conscience. For the same reason you also pay taxes, for the authorities are ministers of God, attending to this very thing. Pay all of them their dues, taxes to whom taxes are due, revenue to whom revenue is due, respect to whom respect is due, honor to whom honor is due. Rom 13:5-7.

Remind them to be submissive to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready for any honest work. Titus 3:1.

Be subject for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether it be to the emperor as supreme, or to governors as sent by him to punish those who do wrong and to praise those who do right. I Peter 2:13, 14.

TO HUSBANDS.

Likewise you husbands, live considerately with your wives, bestowing honor on the woman as the weaker sex, since you are joint heirs of the grace of life, in order that your prayers may not be hindered. And do not be harsh with them. I Peter 3:7; Col. 3:19.

TO WIVES.

Wives, be subject to your husbands, as to the Lord. Eph. 6:4

As Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him Lord. And you are not her children if you do right and let nothing terrify you. I Peter 3:6.

TO PARENTS.

Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord. Eph. 6:4

TO CHILDREN.

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. "Honor your father and mother" (this is the first commandment with a promise), "that it may be well with you and that you may live long on the earth". Eph 6:1-3

TO SERVANTS, HIRED MEN, AND EMPLOYEES.

Slaves, be obedient to those who are your earthly masters, with fear and trembling, in singleness of heart, as to Christ; not in the way of eye-service, as men-pleasers, but as servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart, rendering service with a good will as to the Lord and not to men, knowing that whatever good any one does, he will receive the same again from the Lord, whether he is a slave or free. Eph.6:5-8.

TO EMPLOYERS.

Masters, do the same to them, and forbear threatening, knowing that he who is both their Master and yours is in heaven, and that there is no partiality with him. Eph.6:9.

TO THE YOUNG IN GENERAL.
